	<b>Dusty Sage</b>	#A9B09B	muted sage
	<b>Pale Celadon</b>	#D7DED1	cool soft green
	<b>Mullein Moss</b>	#7F8B63	mossed olive
	<b>Leaf Shadow</b>	#66725A	deep grey-green


## Summer

	Name	Hex	How to think of it
	<b>Flower Spike</b>	#D5B419	mullein yellow
	<b>Sunlit Ochre</b>	#C9A33C	golden ochre
	<b>Chartreuse Stem</b>	#A9A640	yellow-green
	<b>Olive Field</b>	#6F7340	olive green
	<b>Warm Pollen</b>	#E3D37A	soft warm yellow

## Fall

	Name	Hex	How to think of it
	<b>Dried Seedhead</b>	#B88A4A	warm camel
	<b>Straw Gold</b>	#C29C64	dry straw
	<b>Weathered Tan</b>	#9C7755	earthy tan
	<b>Muted Rust</b>	#8A5A39	soft rust brown
	<b>Late Earth</b>	#6D4E38	deep soil brown

## Winter

	Name	Hex	How to think of it
	<b>Ash Stem</b>	#8C8177	stem grey-brown
